1.2 Damages

1.4 Driving permit for Sunday

1.5 Additional overnight stay at the Hockenheimring

For participants who cannot leave before 12th of May 2025, there is the possibility to use a parking space in the Contikreisel (area across the paddock entrance). Because the areas in the paddock and the pits will already be used by the next organizer, the paddock has to be cleared latest by Sunday, 11th of May 2025 – 8 p.m..





2. Paddock

2.1 Paddock entry and exit

Paddock 1:	Wednesday, 7 th of May 2025 – 8 a.m. – 9 p.m.
Paddock 2 & Pit entry:	Wednesday, 7 th of May 2025 – starting 12 midday Thursday, 8 th of May 2025 – 7 a.m. – 12 midnight
Pit exit:	Sunday, 11 th of May 2025 – until 8 a.m.
Paddock exit:	Sunday, 11 th of May 2025 – until 8 a.m.

If you are arriving at the Hockenheimring before the defined entry times, we will set up a sufficient space for you to wait.

2.2 Motorhomes / Trailers

Motorhomes and empty car trailers have to be brought out of the paddock to designated areas (see attachment 4 "Paddock plan").

2.3 Electronic pit keys

The pit key will be handed out at the Sachs-Haus by Melanie Herzog. The deposit per key is 100€ The deposit will be given back to you when you return the key. The keys can be collected and returned at the Sachs-Haus daily between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. during the event week. Use an online reader to activate the electronic pit key. This activation lasts until the following day at 11.59 p.m.. The key must then be reactivated.

4. DOCUMENT CHECK

Document checks for all series take place on Thursday in the Sachs-Haus and on Friday in the RAVENOL-Haus. All the documents required for the participation in the event will be given to you. Please bring your registration documents with you.

What do you need for the document check:

- Valid driver's license
- Valid applicant license (if applicants are present), if required an original power of attorney with a copy of the license (in the case of international applicant licenses, an applicant license must be submitted, which shows the right of representation)
- International starting permits for international participants who don't have a license from the DMSB

5. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

German participants: valid DMSB/FIA car pass

- International participants: valid car pass from the relevant international sports authority (ASN)
- Mandatory safety equipment
- For historic cars according to Appendix K, a Historic Technical Passport (HTP) from the responsible ASN is required
